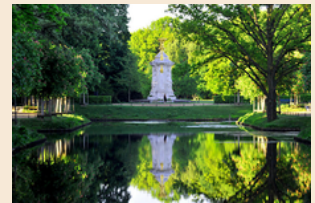

Totally German Celebrating Mothers in Germany



In Germany, Mother's Day (**Muttertag**) is a super special day! It is celebrated on the second Sunday in May, and it is a time to show our mothers (**Mütter**) just how much they are loved and appreciated.



On Muttertag, a lot of children give their mums flowers (**Blumen**), like pretty roses (**Rosen**), colourful carnations or even sweet-smelling lilies.



These are the most common flowers to give on Mother's Day in Germany. A tradition that still holds today is wearing a white carnation in memory of a mother that has



died or wearing a red carnation in honour of a mother that is still living.



And guess what? Some families go to church (**Kirche**) on Mother's Day too, to celebrate how important mums and guardians are in the family. But no matter how they celebrate, the day is all about love, fun, and making all beloved persons feel happy.



Many families start the day with breakfast (**Frühstück**) in bed. That means toast, juice, and even pancakes or croissants— served by the kids! Sometimes, families in



Germany will have a fun family meal together, where everyone sits around the table to enjoy delicious food (**Essen**).

Let's see a recipe (**Kochrezept**) that can be cooked on Mother's Day. And who knows? Maybe you can try it yourself at home and taste this delicacy! It is so easy to make and is a traditional way to use leftovers in Berlin. It is called **Hoppel Poppel**.

Ingredients:

- 500g left-over cooked meat
- 1-2 onions, chopped
- 4 tablespoons butter or olive oil
- 700g left-over boiled potatoes
- salt, pepper
- 6 to 8 eggs



Method:

1. Cut potatoes into slices.
2. Fry the onions in 2 tablespoons butter or oil. Once translucent, add the meat that has been thinly cut into strips.
3. Add remaining butter or oil and the potatoes.
4. Continue frying till potatoes are golden brown.
5. Season with salt and pepper.
6. Mix the eggs and pour over the meat and potatoes. Carefully stir until eggs are set.
