- ❖ Certificate/Diploma in Language Proficiency in German (part-time)
- ❖ B.A. / B.A. (Hons.) in German (full-time or part-time)
- ❖ M.A. in German (full-time or part-time)
- ❖ Ph.D. in German (full-time or part-time)

# Certificate/Diploma in Language Proficiency

- ❖ Certificate: From beginner level to B1 (CEFR)
- ❖ Diploma: From level B1 to C1 (CEFR), the language level required to study in Germany
- ❖ For students of all faculties, staff members and the general public
- ❖ One session per week
- ❖ Spread over six semesters (each)
- ❖ Focus on applied German



# B.A. / B.A. (Hons.) in German (full-time or part-time)

- ❖ Entry Requirement: A level in German (Grade C or better) / Or: B2 Language Certificate
- ❖ Duration of the course: three years (full-time) or six years (part-time)
- ❖ All students follow a combination of two subjects (German + X)
- ❖ 2nd year: students decide if they want to specialise and write a B.A. dissertation (B.A. Honours)

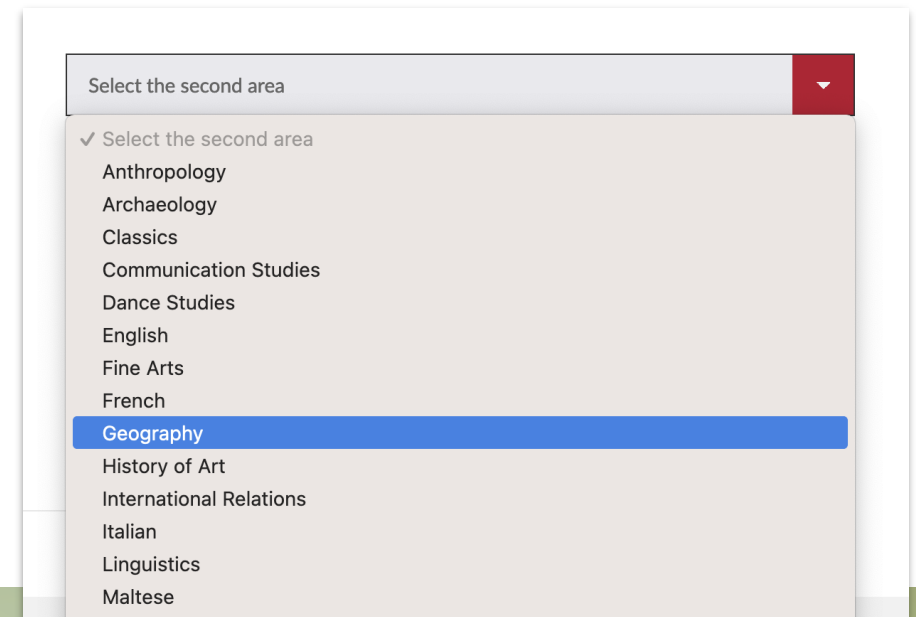


# Subject combinations for a B.A. in German

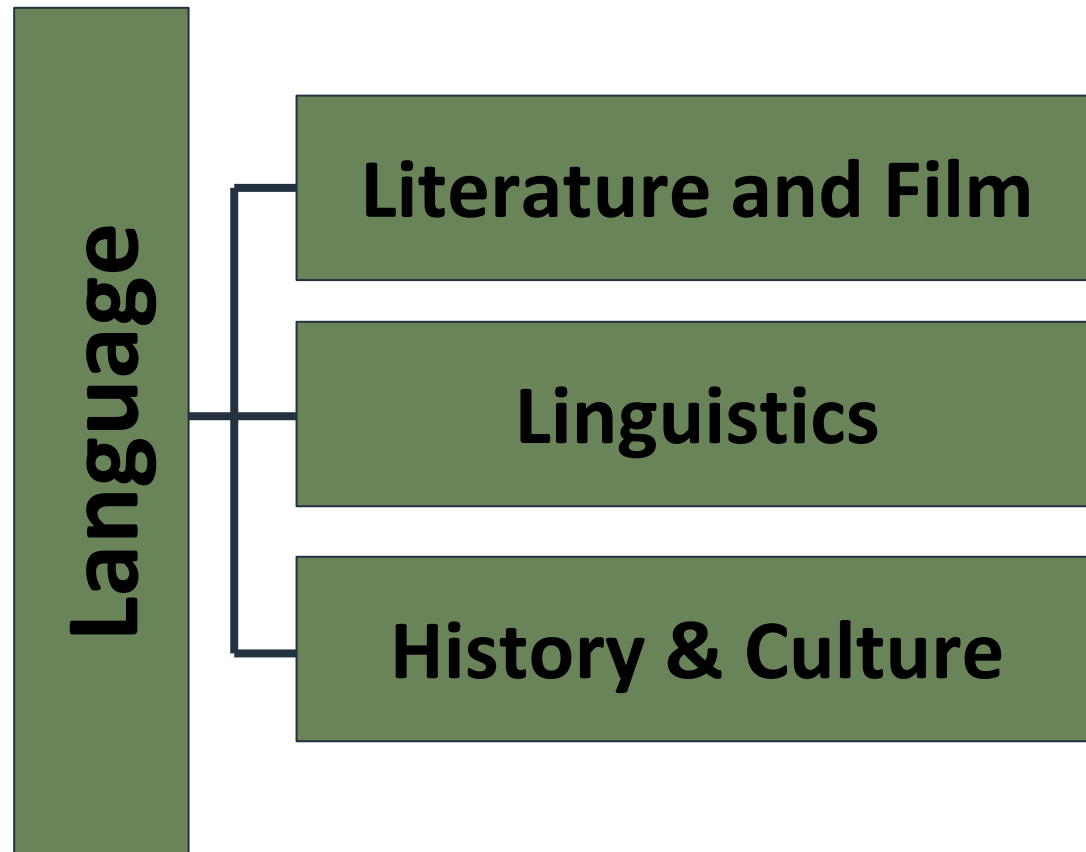
More than 20 possible combinations!

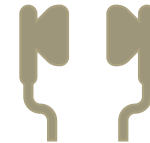
