

Bilbao

Bilbao is a city in northern Spain, the largest city in the province of Biscay and in the Basque Country as a whole. It is also the largest city in northern Spain. Bilbao is the tenth largest city in Spain, with a population of 345,141. The Bilbao metropolitan area has 1,037,847 inhabitants, making it one of the most populous metropolitan areas in northern Spain.

Bilbao is situated in the north-central part of Spain, 16 kilometres south of the Bay of Biscay, where there is the economic-social development of the city. It's main urban core is surrounded by two small mountain ranges with an elevation of 400 metres (1,300 ft). Its climate is shaped by the Bay of Biscay which has mild air, moderating summer temperatures, low sunshine and high rainfall.

Bilbao is also home to the football team called Athletic Club, one of the most successful clubs in the Spanish football history.
